As the Interim Editor of the Bulletin of the EAFP, I regret to inform our readership that I have retracted the article titled "Streptococcosis in Nile Tilapia Farming: A Severe yet Overlooked Health Challenge in Mexico, a Study Case in Campeche, Mexico" by Amelia Isabel Paredes-Trujillo and Manuel Mendoza Carranza, published in the Bulletin of the EAFP on 21 December 2024. The DOI of this article is 10.48045/001c.127774.

Regrettably, Ethical and scientific concerns were raised regarding the study on 5 February 2025. These include concerns about authorship, funding allocation, data ownership, and the science described. Authors were consulted by myself, and the case was further evaluated with Dr. Annette Boerlage the Editor of the Bulletin of the EAFP. A retraction was confirmed as the appropriate course of action.

The integrity and credibility of the scientific record are of paramount importance to the bulletin of the EAFP, and as such, we take these matters very seriously. We are committed to ensuring that published research adheres to the highest ethical and scientific standards. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused to our readers and the broader scientific community.
